

All entries must be processed online. A confirmation email will be sent following the completion of each completed transaction. www.theopenworlds.dance

Tickets can be purchased online in advance or at the Welcome Desk throughout the event.

Email confirmation is proof of entry and ticket purchases.

Admission, Entry and Seat purchases are NON-REFUNDABLE & TRANSFERABLE. In the event of a visa application being denied a refund will be given if official proof of the refusal can be shown.

Late Entries (after 11 April 2024) will be accepted at the organisers discretion. All competitors entering late will incur a 25% surcharge with the fee being non-refundable or transferable from when payment is made.

The organiser has the right to refuse entry or remove, without explanation, anyone attempting to or attending The Open Worlds.

The Teacher or Partner determines the students dance level. Each student can dance in two or more adjacent levels.

All Juvenile and Restricted Syllabus listed events must adhere to The Open Worlds Syllabus. Closed categories have the syllabus restrictions based on the level and can be found on the website.

Age Groups are clearly determined by the age/s of the student, dancer or couple. It is permitted that participants can additionally dance in one age group higher or lower depending on the age and category. This information is clearly explained on the entry form and will be strictly adhered to.

Information on the Dress Rules can be found on the website.

It is at the organisers discretion that due to unforeseen circumstances the scheduled time of an event can be changed. All competition participants are advised to collect their number and be in the Ballroom at least thirty minutes prior to the start of their competition. The organisers hold no responsibility if any couple is not present, in which circumstances the entry fee will not be returned.
